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# Executive Summary

# Assessing State Charter School Performance

In 2016, the State Charter Schools Commission of Georgia (SCSC) adopted a Comprehensive Performance Framework (CPF) to set forth clear, quantifiable, rigorous, and attainable goals in the areas of academic achievement, financial viability, and organizational compliance. A school's performance on the CPF informs SCSC decision making over the course of the charter term and at renewal.

- The academic portion of the CPF incorporates various components of the College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI, Georgia's state accountability tool) and predictive indicators that control for a school's unique and/or challenging student population.
- The financial portion of the CPF includes short-term and long-term measures to assess the school's financial viability.
- The organizational portion of the CPF reflects the school's ability to comply with all applicable laws (state and federal), rules and regulations.

State Charter Schools are expected to meet academic, financial, and operational standards during every year of the charter term. However, schools that demonstrates a consistent track record of strong performance over multiple years may earn a standard five-year renewal. Additionally, schools that finish their first charter term strong (despite early struggles), and schools that consistently perform on par with the attendance zone they serve may earn an abbreviated three-year charter renewal. The intent of an abbreviated charter term is to assess the school's ability to sustain the requisite performance level.

SCSC renewal eligibility criteria are meant to serve as a guideline to inform renewal decisions. However, the SCSC may exercise discretion in approving renewal terms outside of these guidelines.

## Academic Section of the Comprehensive Performance Framework

The academic portion of the CPF assesses a variety of indicators to measure a school's performance in alignment with the SCSC's mission. The academic portion of the CPF seeks to answer the following fundamental question:

- Is the educational program offering students a better educational opportunity than they would otherwise receive in traditional district schools?

***“The mission of the SCSC is to improve public education throughout the state by authorizing high-quality charter schools that provide students with better educational opportunities than they would otherwise be afforded in traditional schools.”***

In any year of the charter term, a state charter school may satisfy annual academic requirements, and be considered **Meeting** SCSC academic standards, by outperforming its attendance zone on any one or combination of following measures (each measure is described in detail on pages 3-7 of this document):

- CCRPI Single Score,
- CCRPI Content Mastery,
- CCRPI Progress,
- CCRPI Grade Band Score,
- Value-Added Impact on Student Achievement

OR by earning a “Beating the Odds” designation from the Georgia Department of Education (GaDOE)

For schools that serve multiple grade bands, a combination of grade band measures (CCRPI Content Mastery, CCRPI Progress, CCRPI Grade Band, and Value-Added Model (VAM) scores) can be used to demonstrate performance. The school must outperform on any one or combination of grade band measures in all grade bands served.

If a state charter school performs as well as, no more than 3% below, the attendance zone, or the state charter school outperforms the attendance zone in one but not all grade bands served, the school is considering **Approaching** SCSC academic standards.

If the state charter school fails to outperform or perform as well as, the attendance zone on any academic measure in all grade bands served, the school is designated as **Not Meeting** SCSC academic standards.

## Attendance Zone Comparison Scores Explained

The SCSC uses three different methods to calculate attendance zone scores for comparison on each CCRPI measures. A school is considered meeting standards if it outperforms any one or combination of the comparison calculations across academic metrics.

**District Average:** The District Average score is the score of the district(s) included in its attendance zone. If a school serves a single district, it is compared to that district's score. If the school serves multiple districts, its score is compared to the simple average of those districts. If the school has a statewide attendance zone, the school is compared to the state average. The SCSC uses GaDOE CCRPI reports to determine the comparison scores.

**District Weighted:** The District Weighted score is comprised of the proportion of students the school enrolls from each district served. If a school serves a single district, it is compared to that district's score because 100% of students enrolled in the state charter school are zoned to attend that district. However, if a school serves multiple districts or has a statewide attendance zone, a district weighted comparison score is generated based on the proportion of students the school enrolls from each district. For instance, if the state charter school enrolls 80% of its students from District A and 20% from District B, then the comparison score will be comprised of 80% of District A's CCRPI score and 20% of District B's CCRPI score. The SCSC uses the GaDOE Data Collections Full-Time Equivalent System of Residency report to determine district enrollment proportions.

**School Weighted:** The School Weighted score is comprised of the proportion of students the state charter school enrolls from each school attendance zone served. The student -level address element in the GaDOE Data Collections Student Record report is used to determine which school each student enrolled in a state charter school is actually zoned to attend (the traditional district school the student would otherwise attend if they were not enrolled in the state charter school). The SCSC weights the CCRPI scores of those schools based on the proportion of students enrolled. The same process that is used to generate the District Weighted score is employed to generate the School Weighted score at the more granular level. For instance, if the state charter school enrolls 80% of its students from School A and 20% from School B, then the comparison score will be comprised of 80% of School A's CCRPI score and 20% of School B's CCRPI score.

The Academic Accountability Report Appendix includes the enrollment proportions for both the District Weighted and School Weighted comparison scores. The Academic Accountability Report Appendix is a separate accompanying document to the Academic Accountability Report.

# Academic Measures Explained

**College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI):** The CCRPI is the official state accountability metric for public schools in Georgia. A school or district CCRPI Single Score is the combination of the CCRPI Grade Band Scores weighted based on the proportion of students enrolled in each grade band. A school and district's CCRPI Grade Band Score and CCRPI Single Score are based on points earned in five areas where weights vary by grade band (elementary, middle, high). Each component is scored on a 0-100-point scale as is the overall score:

- **Content Mastery** (30%, 30%, 30%)
  - Includes achievement in English language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies weighted by Achievement Level. Scores for all students or a subgroup of students will be adjusted if the participation rate for that group is less than 95%.
- **Progress/ Growth** (35%, 35%, 30%)
  - Utilizes student growth percentiles (SGPs), which compare a student's growth with other students with similar past achievement, in English language arts and mathematics on state assessments (weighted by level of growth) and progress towards English language proficiency for EL students. (ACCESS indicator currently used in CCRPI, now weighted by level of progress)
- **Closing Gaps** (15%, 15%, 10%)
  - Utilizes progress toward meeting achievement improvement targets, where the target is a 3% increase between a baseline year of data and 100%. Targets are set for all student and all subgroups.
- **Readiness** (20%, 20%, 15%)
  - Elementary school indicators include literacy (Lexiles = grades 3-5), student attendance, and beyond the core (earning a passing score in fine arts or world language).
  - Middle school indicators include literacy (Lexiles = grades 6- 8), student attendance, and beyond the core (earning a passing score in fine arts, world language, career exploratory, or physical education/health).
  - High school indicators include literacy (Lexiles = 9th Grade Literature and American Literature), student attendance, accelerated enrollment, pathway completion, college and career readiness (combines college readiness, end of pathway assessment, and work-based learning).
- **Graduation Rate** (NA, NA, 15%)
  - Includes 4- and 5-year adjusted cohort graduation rates. No component is included for elementary and middle schools

**Value-Added Model (VAM):** The Value-Added Model (VAM) is a statistical predictive measure generated by the Governor’s office of Student Achievement (GOSA) that allows the SCSC to measure a school’s contribution to student performance while mitigating the impact of a student’s demographic, academic, and socio-economic background on his/her current achievement level. The VAM adjusts for the observable characteristics of students so that schools can be equitably compared regardless of their differing student populations. The VAM follows a two-step process and is designed to compare performance of schools that serve observationally similar students. Individual current year student test scores are estimated as a function of individual-level prior year test scores, individual student characteristics, and school-level demographics. The inclusion of school-level student characteristics is meant to “level the playing field” by not only controlling for the characteristics of each student, but also the general school context.

Any differences between the estimated score and the actual score are attributed to differences in school quality -- the value-added impact the school has on the student’s performance. In the Two-Step VAM, the expected performance of a student depends on both their own characteristics and the average characteristics of the student body in the school they attend. Value-added impact scores represent all ELA and Math tested subjects at the school. A state charter school is considered “outperforming” if its overall impact on student performance is statistically higher than that of its comparison district(s) as measured by an all-subject average in all relevant grade bands.

**Statistical Controls Used in the Value-Added Analysis:**

**At the student level:** 1) Prior-year test scores, 2) gender, 3) foreign-born indicator, 4) race/ethnicity, 5) ESOL enrollment, 6) free/reduced-price lunch eligibility, 7) gifted status, 8) primary-language-not-English indicator, 9) disability status (fifteen specific disability categories), 10) number of schools attended in the current year, 11) an indicator for students who changed schools from the prior year, 12) number of disciplinary incidents in the prior year, 13) attendance in the prior year, and 14) the difference between a student’s age (in months) and the modal age of students in the same grade (i.e. “overage” in grade), 15) previously withdrawn for reasons identified as risk factors, 16) late enrollees.

**At the school level:** the proportion of 1) directly certified students, 2) limited English proficiency students, and 3) students with disabilities.

**Beating the Odds (BTO):** The Beating the Odds (BTO) evaluation was developed by the Georgia Department of Education (GaDOE) to measure the performance of charter schools on an annual basis. BTO is a statistical analysis that compares a school's actual performance on the College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) with the performance of schools with similar characteristics across the state. Schools that perform higher than similar schools are considered "Beating the Odds." It is important to note that schools that "Beat the Odds" may still have low CCRPI scores and/or gaps in performance.

While BTO, VAM and the CCRPI are all useful school-level accountability tools, they were created for different purposes and include different performance indicators. As a result, comparisons between CCRPI scores, the BTO and VAM are sometimes difficult to make. For instance, because BTO/VAM scores are produced by comparing actual and predicted student performance on state accountability metrics while also controlling for student demographics, there are instances in which a school may be outperforming its comparison district on the CCRPI, yet it has a negative value-add impact score and/or is not "beating the odds". This indicates that the school's actual performance was lower than its predicted performance (given the characteristics and performance history of the school's student population). In other words, the school was predicted to perform at an even higher level. Or a school may not be outperforming its comparison district on the CCRPI, yet it has a positive value-add impact score and/or is "beating the odds". This indicates that the school's actual performance exceeds its predicted performance (given the characteristics and performance history of the school's student population). In other words, the school was predicted to perform at a lower level.

**Statistical Controls Used in the Beating the Odds Calculation:**

**At the school level:** 1) Race/ethnicity, 2) disability status, 3) ELL status, 4) economically disadvantaged as identified by Direct Certification, 5) gender, 6) school size, 7) grade cluster, 8) student mobility as measured by churn rate, and 9) non-traditional school designation<sup>3</sup>
