

FY22 GOVERNANCE TRAINING REQUIREMENT FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the requirement?	Georgia law, O.C.G.A. § 20-2-2084(f), requires that every member of a governing board of a state charter school participate in annual governing board training.		
Who must participate in governance training?	Every member of a governing board of a state charter school must participate in annual governing board training. Board members who join a state charter school governing board after the final SCSC governance training opportunity are encouraged, but not required to, participate in governance training for that fiscal year. <i>IMPORTANT NOTE: Administrators and school staff are encouraged to attend governance training with their governing board as doing so fosters a collaborative relationship between the governing board and school administration. However, school staff and administrators are not required to receive governance training.</i>

Attend one of the three governing board training opportunities offered by the SCSC at <u>no charge.</u> <u>REGISTER HERE</u>	Use personal or school funds to make alternate training arrangements through a <u>training provider</u> approved by the State Board of Education.	
	OPTION 2 is <u>not available</u> for newly approved schools in their planning year i.e. Year 0.		
Who are the approved alternate training providers?	The list of training providers approved by the State Board of Education can be found <u>here</u> . Only governance training provided by providers approved by the State Board of Education to provide governance training to charter schools will meet SCSC governance training requirements.		
If I choose alternate training, what are my responsibilities?	 Choose a provider that is approved to conduct governance training for the current fiscal year. Communicate <u>SCSC- required content topics</u> to your provider and ensure that the alternate training aligns with them. Ensure that you receive 12 contact hours of instruction. This means 12 hours of direct instruction whether in-person or virtually. Maintain verification of your participation in alternate training. You must have a certificate of completion/participation issued by an approved training provider and a syllabus for the alternate training you received. 		
What if I am not able to fully attend both days of governance training provided by the SCSC?	 If you are unable to fully attend SCSC governance training, you may make up the remainder of your required training hours either by: Arranging for your own alternate training through an SBOE approved provider or; Attendance at a professional conference whose content: a) aligns with the SCSC required topics and; b) is delivered by an approved training provider. Board members who choose to split up their training hours in this way are responsible for keeping track of the number of training hours they get from each training opportunity as well as the content areas covered. When is the deadline for			
completion of the requirement?	Every governing board member holding office during the fiscal year must have fulfilled his or her governance training requirements. The deadline for Local Board Governance and the Charter Governance Board Training reports for FY22 is <u>June 30, 2022</u> . State charter school boards must provide evidence of fulfillment of the requirement in their application for governance certification in the SCSC administrative portal. The governance certification application deadline will be communicated by SCSC staff.
