



Letter of Intent

This Letter of Intent (LOI) application is for existing Georgia charter schools planning to submit an SCSC petition for charter replication. To be eligible to submit a petition for charter replication, a petitioner must:

- be an existing state or local charter school in Georgia;
- maintain a performance track record that meets the eligibility criteria in the State Charter Schools Commission of Georgia's Replication Policy; and,
- complete and submit this LOI application on or before 11:59 p.m. (EST) on December 31, 2024.

Eligibility to submit a charter replication petition does not guarantee SCSC petition approval. The SCSC will only make replication petitions available to petitioners who meet the criteria above. Submitting an LOI application does not obligate an organization to submit a petition.

Interested persons are strongly encouraged to review the SCSC [Replication Policy](#), [SCSC Rule 691-2-.02 State Charter School Petitions](#), and the resources on the [SCSC "Start a School" webpage](#) prior to submitting a LOI application.

The information provided in this LOI application is not binding. The SCSC will provide the replication application only to schools that meet the letter of intent deadline and requirements.
