STATE CHARTER SCHOOLS COMMISSION OF GEORGIA GRADE BAND POLICY

Article I Purpose

The purpose of this grade band policy is to ensure that the State Charter Schools Commission of Georgia (SCSC) approves charter petitions and amendments in a manner that promotes transparency and educational continuity.

Article II Definitions

- 1. For purposes of this policy, the term grade band shall refer to grade level groupings categorized as elementary school (grades K-5), middle school (grades 6-8), or high school (grades 9-12).
- 2. For purposes of this policy, the term enrollment plan shall refer to the grade configuration included in the charter petition that indicates the number of students and individual grade levels a petitioner plans to serve each year of operation. The enrollment plan may or may not be included in the charter contract.

Article III Policy

The grade range provision in all state charter school contracts shall include one or more complete grade bands. This policy shall not constrain a charter school from serving less than all grade levels within a grade band in accordance with its enrollment plan.
