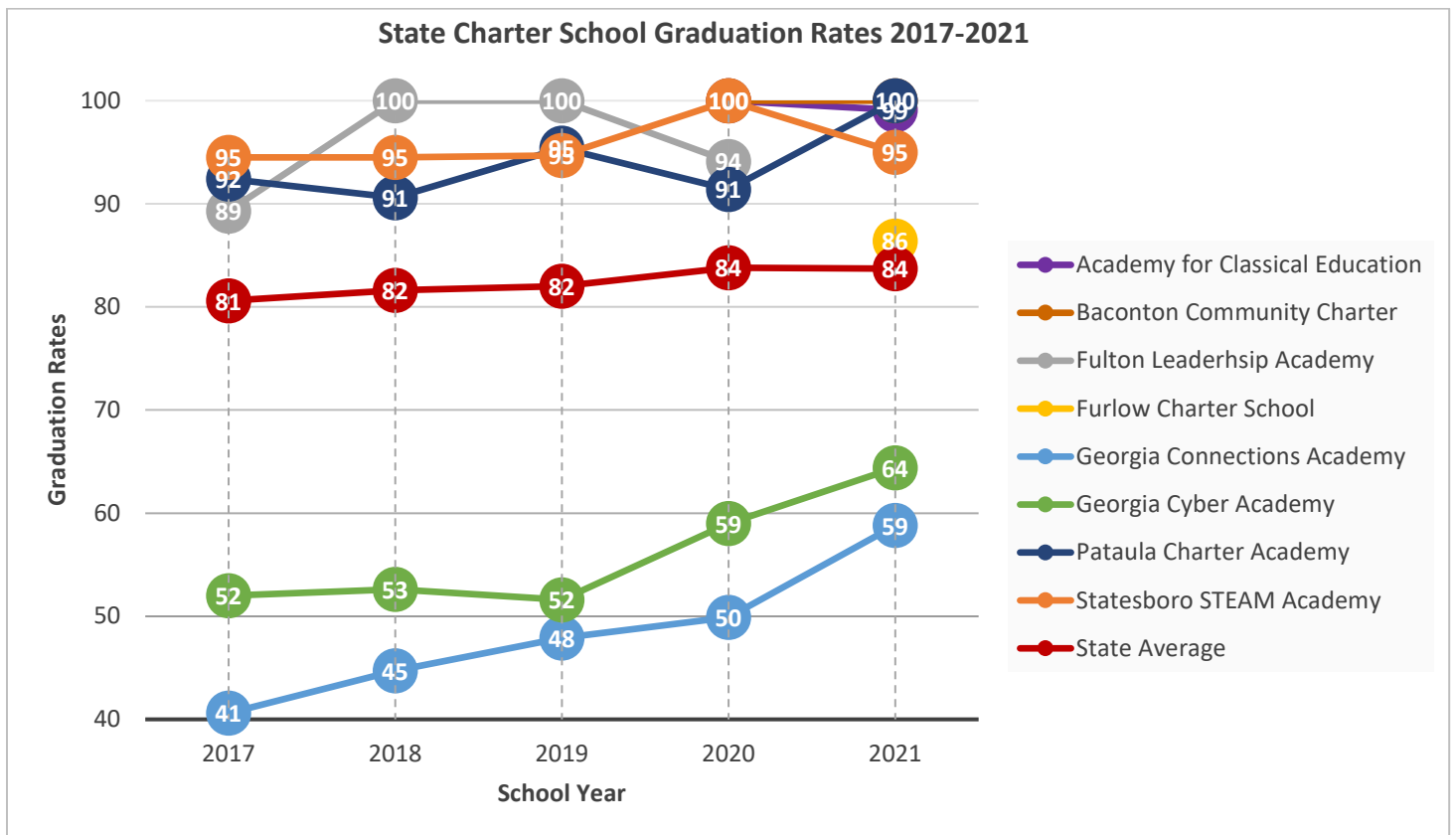


State Charter Schools Graduation Rate 2021 Update

- Four state charter schools had graduation rates over 95%, two of which had 100%.
- A majority of state charter schools (5 of 7) had graduation rates higher than the state average, 83.7, in 2021.
- A majority of state charter schools (4 of 7) had graduation rates higher than the attendance zone they serve.
- Three state charters increased the graduation rate from the year prior, including the two statewide virtual schools.
- Two state charters maintained the graduation rate from the year prior.
- Two state charters' graduation rates decreased from the year prior; however, both still have rates above 95%.
- Two schools had too few students to report scores for 2021.¹
