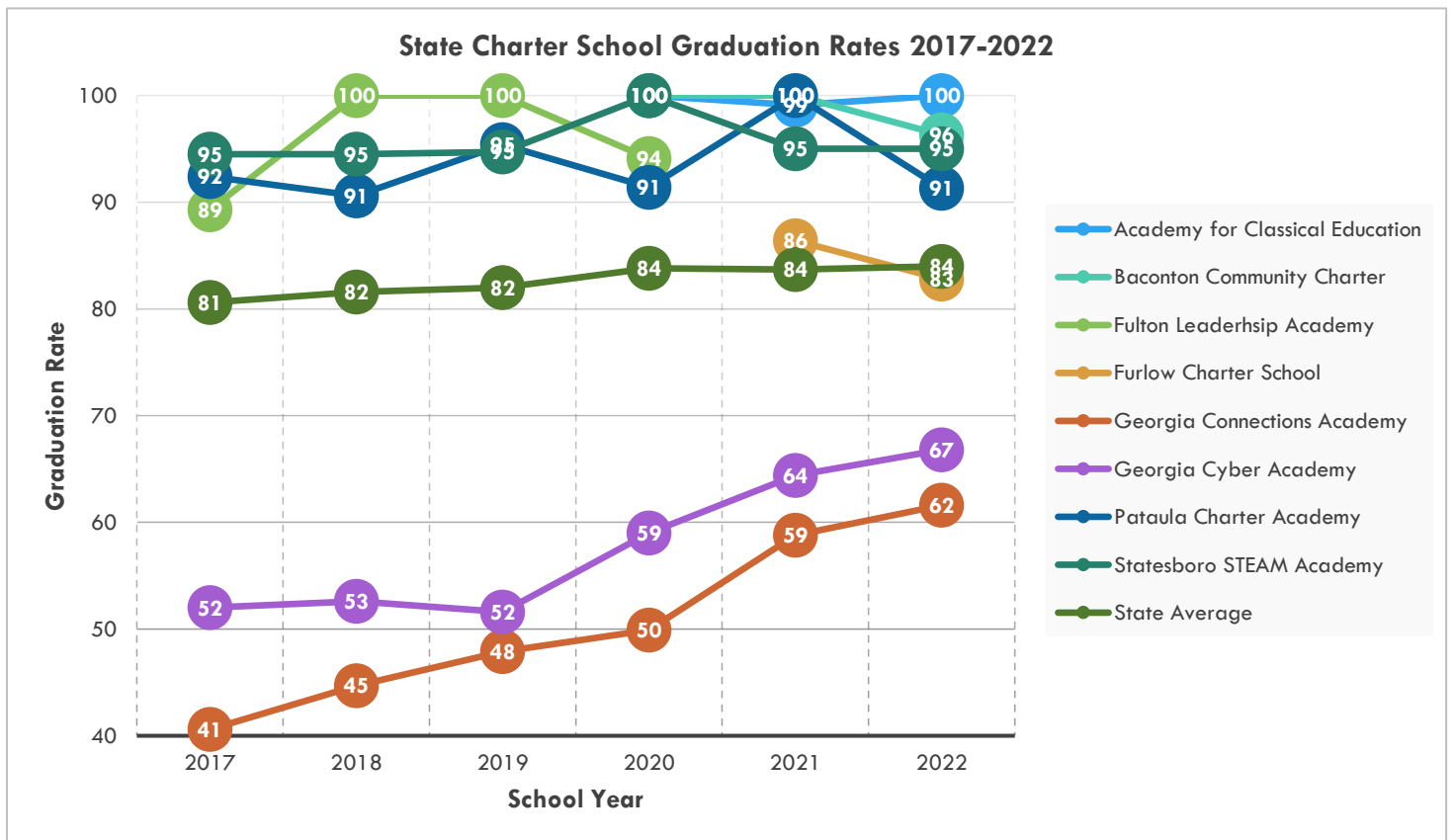


State Charter Schools Graduation Rate 2022 Update

- A majority of state charter schools (4 of 7) had graduation rates higher than the state average, 84.1, in 2022.
- Three state charter schools had graduation rates higher than all districts within the attendance zone they serve.
- Three state charters increased the graduation rate from the year prior, including the two statewide virtual schools.
- One state charter school maintained the graduation rate from the year prior.
- Three state charters' graduation rates decreased from the year prior.
- Two schools, Fulton Leadership Academy and Georgia Fugees, had too few students to report scores for 2022.
