Meeting Minutes

- 4. At approximately 1:25 pm, Commissioner Perez, Sam Rauschenberg, Sarah Beck, and Representative Mike Glanton joined the interview panel. The interview panel then met with the governing board of Genesis Academy for Boys and Genesis Academy for Girls. The governing board of the proposed state charter schools provided a brief overview of the schools' models. The interview panel then questioned the proposed schools' need for single-gender education, the governing board's capacity to operate as an LEA, and methods to hold the school leader accountable. The interview concluded at approximately 3:20 pm.
