Notice of Proposed Rulemaking – November 16, 2016


To all interested parties, notice is hereby provided as required by O.C.G.A. § 50-13-4 that the State Charter Schools Commission of Georgia (SCSC) proposes to initiate rulemaking procedures to amend rules 691-2-.02 State Charter School Petitions and 691-2-.03 State Charter School Monitoring.

The authority for this rulemaking is provided by Chapter 2, Article 31A of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia, specifically O.C.G.A. §§ 20-2-2082, 2083, 2084, and 2091. The SCSC proposes to to amend rules 691-2-.02 State Charter School Petitions and 691-2-.03 State Charter School Monitoring.

Opportunity for oral hearing shall be granted if requested by 25 persons who will be directly affected by the proposed rule, by a governmental subdivision, or by an association having at least 25 members.
