Synopsis of Proposed New Rule 691-2-.06 State Charter School Sites and Facilities

The State Charter Schools Commission of Georgia (SCSC) proposes to initiate rulemaking procedures to create a new rule 691-2-.03 State Charter School Sites and Facilities. This proposed new rule describes the responsibility for state charter schools to adhere to applicable rules and laws to receive appropriate approval from the Georgia Department of Education for the use of a facility for educational purposes and to abide by all rules and law related to student safety and security. The proposed new rule would also require state charter schools to provide the SCSC copies of their lease, rental agreement, or evidence of title to the SCSC for the facilities they utilize and to receive prior approval from the SCSC Executive Director prior to adding or changing a facility.
